... Is a major source of Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs) and an area source of hazardous air pollutants (HAPs)

1.9 TONS OF HAPS (2022)



HAPs are associated with an the increased risk of:

- CANCER
- DEVELOPMENTAL EFFECTS
- REPRODUCTIVE DYSFUNCTIONS
- NEUROLOGICAL DISORDERS
- HERITABLE GENE MUTATIONS
- IMMUNE SYSTEM DAMAGE

... Emits chemicals that, even at low levels, can negatively impact the community around them

ETHYL BENZENE AT DG3

Classified as both a Hazardous Air Pollutant (HAP) and a Volatile Organic Compound (VOC), which functions as a highly volatile carcinogen



VOC odors, even relatively low levels can cause

Eye, nose and throat irritation
Headaches
Nosebleeds
Fatigue
Nausea
Dizziness
Allergic skin reaction
Vision and memory loss



... Is located between Camp Liberty and Liberty State Park

0.3 miles from Camp Liberty
0.8 miles from Liberty State Park

Jersey City has the highest adult asthma rates in Hudson County

Health Risks

Exposure to pollutants emitted from an area source can lead to **adverse health effects, especially respiratory issues**, allergies, and other related concerns.



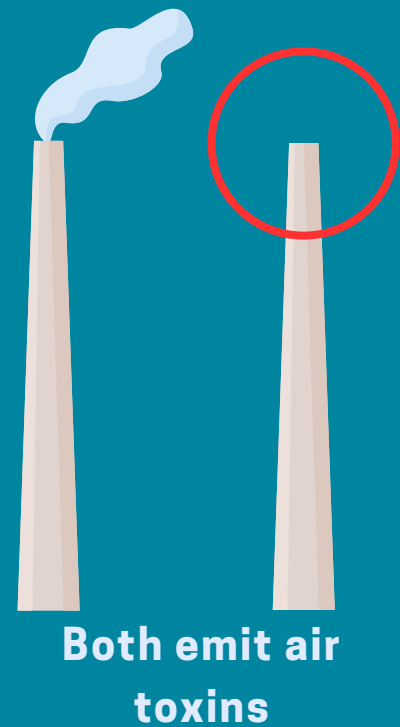
... Did not prepare an Environmental Justice Impact Statement

Even though they are a facility with an “**undefined**” **smoke stack** next to a summer camp.



Imagine having a constantly idling car (VOCs) in your driveway, emitting exhaust directly into your surroundings.

This means emissions are typically dispersed **more widely and closer to the ground** which means that the area surrounding DG3 may **experience widespread pollution, affecting areas like Liberty State Park**



Both emit air toxins

Did you know that the Diversified Global Graphics Group (DG3)...

The NJDEP states that all facilities applying for permit renewal must “...[F]acilitate meaningful opportunities for overburdened communities to engage in permitting decisions for pollution-generating facilities”

-Administrative Order No. 2021-2025

DG3 Resolution

City Council's Resolution Requesting that the NJDEP Grant an **Additional Extension of Time for Public Comment and Input Regarding Diversified Global Graphics' Title V Operating Permit** and If Facts Warrant Conduct Further Fact Finding in Response to the Application for the Permit
